Footnotes

WELL MEANT was pinched back after breaking slowly, raced far back early, rapidly gained inside on the turn, angled five wide for room at the top of the stretch and unleashed a strong late run to win going away. DAKOTA BOB raced in midpack between horses, swung five wide while splitting horses at the quarter pole, made a move to challenge in upper stretch but couldn't sty with the winner through the final eighth. EARLY RESPONSE saved ground in good position, awaited room midway on the turn, angled four wide nearing the stretch, challenged in upper stretch and held for a share. SWEET GROOM dueled in the two path, opened a clear advantage nearing the quarter pole weakened. CALL TO DUTY was outrun after breaking slowly and rallied belatedly along the rail. PERSONAL SPENDER broke outward at the start, steadied in traffic on the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. J T MOORE chased four wide, swung six wide entering the stretch and tired. MR HONEY split rivals on the turn and failed to threaten. OUR SPECIAL EFFORT rushed up after bobbling at the start, dueled along the rail for a half and gave way. TOWNIE'S DREAM stalked four wide and drifted out while giving way at the quarter pole.
