RUSTY ANCHOR was unhurried early, advanced outside on the second turn and drew clear under a drive. MARLA SUE raced close up inside, came wide into the stretch and rallied to earn the place. GAYLE'S GLORY quickly showed in front, set the pace, tired in the final furlong and bled. LIGHT BAIL chased outside and tired in the stretch. HEROISS was bumped at the start, chased inside and tired in the stretch. MAYVILLE stumbled at the start, was rated along inside and had no rally. CASSIDY'S CODE was steadied entering the first turn and dropped back. HOPEAROO was bumped at the start and was outrun.
