BROTHER BOB got off to an alert beginning, was quickly angled over to the rail, shook free under his own power and set the initial splits on an open lead, had the runner up attempt to crank up the pressure shortly after reaching the far turn, but to no avail, got let out coming to the quarter pole and edged away to a more comfortable advantage once more, held sway, crossing the wire under a hand ride. TAPE IT in the three path on the opening bend, was still off the inside thereafter but closer to the rail, began to close the gap from midway on the backstretch, albeit having yet to make his presence felt, was asked for some run departing the half mile pole then put to a drive soon afterwards, failed to latch on to the top one, held well to the end to take the place. MONEY IN RETURN put to a firm hold for much of the opening half, saved ground until past the three-eighths pole, swung into the lane but proved no match for the top pair. CANDY RAIDER was sent over to the inside soon after entering the backstretch, stayed along the inside route the rest of the way to far turn and beyond, was put to solid encouragement cutting the corner into the lane, lacked the needed response. PRIMAL GOLD strung out four wide on the first turn, travelled in the three path on the subsequent one, folded. PERFECT SUNDAY raced along the outside and was outrun. CASHLEIGH three wide midpoint on the far turn, failed to menace.
