FLAMINGO LANE three wide on the opening bend, continued as wide on the subsequent one, steadily gained ground on the runner up after departing the backstretch, had made her presence by the quarter pole when set down to a drive, won the fight through the furlong grounds to emerge as the new leader, kicked clear while being kept busy. GINGEE took up the role of primary pursuer, kept watch on the pacesetter from the two path, being rated along, took over coming to the seven-sixteenths marker, needing no encouragement from the pilot while doing so, had the rider take a peek back at the winner heading for the top of the lane, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole when asked for a response, yielded, remained well clear of the others for the place. IRATINELEXBURANCE gave chase from near the two path, left the three-eighths pole being driven, cleared the former pacesetter shortly afterwards and was sent over to the inside route, proved no match for the top twosome. VINHDCATION SPOT three wide on the far turn, turned for home having already been put to a drive, tired. PEGASUS BEBA saved ground until the end of the backstretch, swung three wide into the stretch to no avail. KNOCKOUT BEAUTY showed the way towards the inside, relinquished readily when challenged by the second place finisher a few strides past the half mile pole, retreated into last then was eased.
