**Footnotes**

THE BRUSH bumped by MEGAHOLTZ at the start, went on to assume a forward position, contently stalked the leader while three wide around each bend, was asked to pick up the pace leaving the five-sixteenths pole before being placed under much stronger handling soon afterwards, continued onward, despite making little progress during the initial portion of the stretch run, gained more readily leaving the furlong grounds, wrested command away in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and drew clear. CAPTAIN STONE placed under a good hold soon after the start, was rated while stalking the pacesetter from the outside, issued a challenge for the front coming to the quarter pole, sustained the momentum, entering the stretch, grabbing the lead well before reaching the eighth pole, was unable to resist the top one, yielding readily at the sixteenth pole, but held well enough to secure second. GOOD TO BE ME sat reserved taking the inside route, slipped off the rail coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, was kept well in hand, awaiting options, from the two path as the field headed for the top of the stretch, was set down after settling into the stretch, with sufficient racing clearance by this time, but proved to need more. QUE POSSE drafted behind the top one from the three path around both turns, then rallied mildly after turning for home to improve position. SAVANNAH BAY rated on the lead while racing along the inside, gave way. MEGAHOLTZ was bumped after stumbling at the start, settled into the two path for the run around the opening bend, bided time from there during the opening half, was coaxed along to maintain position, angled inward for the stretch run, taking over the position formerly held by GOOD TO BE ME, commenced to rally, under a full drive, and with a clear alleyway at the top of the lane, came outward under strong left handed pressure leaving the furlong grounds, then was forced to be taken in hand, behind rivals with about seventy yards to go. SO MUCH HEART off the inside, trailed.
