GOLD IS GOOD was placed under a snug hold, and eased back coming to the half mile pole, momentarily conceding the front to ULTERIOR MOTIVE, ranged up to press that one more intensely about a sixteenth further in the running, won an abbreviated duel with the aforementioned rival, with the rider still attempting to keep something in reserve, shook free of the competition once let out a notch in upper stretch, holding his biggest edge with an eighth to go, felt pressure from the top one approaching the sixteenth pole, but was kept going well enough, under encouragement, to reach the wire in time. UPPER AFLEET underwent a three wide pursuit and came home with good energy to make a things a bit interesting in the late stages. TONY'S BACK off to an awkward beginning, began to pick up the pace, departing the half mile pole, angled out to the middle of the track after turning for home and finished well belatedly to take the show. KARAKORUM JOE rode the rail until angling outward at the five-sixteenths pole, rallied mildly to earn the last major share. ALL MY CHIPS raced along the outside, was urged along, chasing the front runners on the turn before backing off. BLUE HORSESHOE off the inside, failed to menace. ULTERIOR MOTIVE urged from the gate, took command early, dueled briefly, from the inside, with the top one on the turn and faded. AMPLIFY displayed brief foot.
