POPPA'S PICK sat under a snug hold from the two path for nearly a half, found ample room to tip out an additional path late during the run around the bend, rolled from there into the stretch, bested a more energetically-handled opponent to take charge by midstretch and maintained a safe winning margin, under hand encouragement to the wire. WHO'S THE COWBOY was angled off the rail approaching the quarter pole, and rallied well under strong encouragement to win the battle for the place. AMERICAN CLASSIC coaxed along almost from the get-go, made a successful bid for the lead at the seven-sixteenths pole, came under assault from a pair of rivals heading into the stretch, succumbed to the pressure and had to eventually settle for the show. DEVONSHIRE fanned four wide into the lane, lacked the needed kick. GOOD KARMA raced three wide throughout most of the turn and was never a factor. TAHOE WARRIOR forwardly placed for a half while taking the inside route, gave way. MITIGATION three wide on the turn, folded. MILES HEIR was outrun. HUMILARITY underwent a three wide pursuit and tired badly.
