MOONSHINE BAY broke well and grabbed the early advantage, set the splits while being rated along the inside, got let out just after entering the stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds holding on to his biggest advantage, fended off the runner up in the late stages to preserve the decision. BASALT slipped into the two path after initially tracking the leader from the rail, was roused in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, made no progress on the winner until past the eighth pole, gained well late but fell short. SO SCOTT raced along the outside and lacked the needed late response. SHIPMAKER made inconsequential contact with RESERVED QUALITY at the start, raced three wide and mustered up a mild response in the stretch to mainly improve position. RESERVED QUALITY quickly tucked along the rail, launched an abbreviated move coming to the quarter pole, flattened out. ACT ONE SCENE ONE gave chase on the winner from well off the inside, had already felt the whip right handed bidding three wide for command at the quarter pole, tired.
