VYJACK came away in good order, was proceeding near the inside as a forward factor fighting against the bit as the field headed for the opening turn, raced alongside MUDFLATS for a good portion of the opening half, showed a tendency to try to get out, being kept just off the inside while the rider was applying some pressure on the left side of the rein, and drifting into the two path each time he relaxed the grip, was under stout restraint while grabbing the advantage nearing the end of the backstretch, continued on the front end, being rated in the two path, came under heavy assault nearing the five-sixteenths pole, with the runner up joining in on the action from down along the rail, entered the stretch under encouragement appearing to trail that rival by a sliver, battled on with vigor, with the front runners leaning upon each for a brief period of time in the furlong grounds, got bumped and carried out by the runner up in the deep stretch, but fought back gamely to reclaim the lead and prove best. SIETE DE OROS ducked in slightly at the start, settled down and took the inside route, with the pilot atop with a firm hold in the initial stages, was let out a notch when ready and issued a challenge for command, together with several others as the field was completing three-quarters, gained the slimmest of leads, made slight contact with the top one during the opening round of the stretch drive, arrived at the eighth pole still holding a head advantage, came out after a few left handed shots, carrying out and bumping with VYJACK in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, yielded reluctantly but finished gamely to the end to earn the place. AMERIGO VESPUCCI raced at or near the inside, well rated for the initial half, held well for the show, although no match for the top pair. LONG RIVER nestled amongst foes on the far turn, commenced the stretch drive three wide, got outfinished. VEGAS NO SHOW bobbed at the start, took the three path around the opening turn, was strung out in the fourth one on the subsequent bend, issued an abbreviated bid as the widest of all at the five-sixteenths marker, then backed away. NOTACATBUTALLAMA three wide around both turns, failed to fire when called upon at the head of the stretch. MUDFLATS pulled somewhat on the bit as the early leader, raced on even terms with the eventual winner early down the backstretch before conceding that rival a small lead as the pair made their way towards the half mile pole, pressed the issue three wide until the quarter pole and tired. JAMES JINGLE off a beat slowly, darted over to the inside, saved ground until the quarter pole while trailing throughout.
