### Footnotes

STEALTH MISSILE accompanied the pacesetter from the outside, under a firm hold, for nearly three-quarters, increased the pressure approaching the quarter pole, gained gradually on the leader, reached the sixteenth pole with that opponent only heads apart, went by a couple of jumps later and edged clear, driving. CRAFTY MARK off to a good start, cleared over to the rail in time for the run around the opening bend, cut the pace towards the inside, mildly pressed by the top one all the while, was let out a notch heading for the stretch, reluctantly yielded with a sixteenth to go, but held well to the end to procure the place. MARINA MARKET was taken in hand, as CRAFTY MARK was tucking along the rail, shortly before reaching the first turn, patiently tracked the front runner while taking the inside route, was called upon after settling into the stretch, but proved no match for the top twosome. FRENCH TRANSITION reserved within range off the inside, attempted to reach a contention with a three wide run around the far turn, but wasn't up to the task. R J'S PROSPECT saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, swung outward in preparation for the stretch drive, was put to encouragement angling three wide into the lane, but failed to fire. LARRY'S FORTY TWO off the inside, trailed throughout.
