CEDAR ISLAND broke sharply and was briefly in front on a loose lead, had that advantage snatched away by MY GIRL GRACIE soon afterwards, was taken outward nearing the half mile pole, inadvertently taking a couple of others outward slightly as well, continued the chase from off the inside, closed in on the leader under a long hard drive on the turn, turned for home latched on to the front runner's hind quarters, reached the furlong marker on nearly even terms, battled hard from that station to the wire and out gamed the runner up to earn the decision. MY GIRL GRACIE out sprinted the field under her own power, sailed along setting honest opening splits, had the rider sit chilly in the saddle despite being confronted by the top one approaching the quarter pole, was asked for run for the initial time in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, still clung to a narrow advantage when the rider lost the whip at the eighth pole, battled gamely to the end, but had to settle for being clearly second best. SWEET KAKES shied outward a bit from inside pressure originated by the winner coming to the half mile pole, raced along the outside throughout the run around the bend, proved no match for the top pair. PRINCESS JENNY bumped with KARAKORUM MIRAGE at the break, shifted outward one path shying away from another in the vicinity of the half mile pole, fell back steadily on the two front runners around the turn. BLUSHING KARAKORUM broke outward at the start, was impeded at the half mile pole, being forced to swerve towards the overland route and getting checked, continued from well off the inside thereafter and failed to reach a contending position. EVA LIL off the rail, appeared to get clipped from behind at the end of the backstretch, was never a threat. SO FASHION carried outward several paths at the start, made it to the inside in short order, saved ground and was outrun. KARAKORUM MIRAGE got bumped at the start, sat in midpack from off the inside and tired. MISS DRAGON LADY appeared rank pulling noticeably on the right side of the bit making her way to the half mile pole, was pushed into harm's way at that station, clipping the heels of another and losing the pilot after stumbling. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident down the backstretch before the result was declared official.
