### Footnotes

TOO MUCH STUFF established control shortly after the start, set the splits, being rated along in the two path, began to drift outward a short distance from the quarter pole, commenced the stretch run three wide, basically held a straight course while making his way through the furlong grounds, left it comfortably in the clear, drifted out noticeably thereafter while continuing to draw off, resisting the corrective right handed stick work being applied by the rider. PHYSICAL DELIVERY broke a couple of steps to the outside, raced four wide around the turn and into the stretch, proved no match for the winner, but continued onward in willing fashion to garner the place. MISSED A WILDCAT saved ground and lacked the necessary stretch response. CITY GONE WILD got away a beat slowly from the gate, reached out greenly while striding down the backstretch and quickly fell back, got out and continued to show that inclination throughout the opening half, forcing the rider to counteract the errant ways with constant pressure from the stick on the right side, spun about three wide into upper stretch, was given a few shots before switched over to being hand ridden, displayed the same greenness here as down the backstretch, yet again desiring and getting out, swerved inward sharply during the final seventy yards after a series of right handed shots while flashing belated foot en route for the last major check. BEBES PASSION failed to respond to some right shoulder motivation in the form of choppy strokes leaving the starting gate, quickly tucked along the rail and was never a menace. ARIADNA tracked the winner from the pocket for the opening half before faltering. YOU TAKE THE CAKE chased three wide, at first under confident handling, tired. TRICKY TIFFANY raced along the outside and was outrun.
