AZASECRET broke well, was placed to a firm hold as rivals hustled inside for command, settled tracking three wide from close range, was given some rein to work with at the three-eighths pole and ranged up to pressure the leader at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, came under hand urging at the three-sixteenths, seized command coming the eighth pole, inched away under busy hands to the sixteenth marker when put to a full drive in the late stages to the wire. ROCKY FIELD hustled from the gate, set the pace along the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths as the aforementioned rival ranged up applying some pressure, cut the corner into the stretch, got displaced on the lead nearing the eighth pole, dug in and fought on to the wire to just hold the place honors in a good effort. SWIFT TAYLOR towards the rear four wide, made progress on the turn into prominence coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide for home, offered up a mild kick through the stretch and just missed the place honors. GRACIE TOO three to four wide in pursuit from close range, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, made a mild bid through the stretch but was outfinished in the late stages. SIGNORA SOFIA saved ground at the rear when outrun early on, came under encouragement three furlongs out, swung three wide in upper stretch, shifted to the rail at the three-sixteenths as EVA LIL angled out in front, offered up late energy by mostly tired rivals. EVA LIL hustled at the start, attended the pace from just off the inside briefly to the seven-sixteenths pole, began to retreat coming under a ride at the three-eighths and tired. NINE CRACKS mid pack just off the inside, shifted to the rail midway on the turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and weakened. GALAXY GAL hesitated at the start, settled three wide in mid pack, was ridden along three furlongs out, spun five wide at the quarter pole and tired.
