STORM BOOT GOLD quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside, drew away when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. THE QUEEN'S DOC was hustled along inside and finished well on the rail to earn the place award. BERRYTHEGOLD chased the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. MISTICAL FASTNESS was bumped at the start, chased the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. SMOKIN' KELLY was pinched back at the start, was outrun early, raced inside, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. TAKE ME OUT JOHN raced three wide and tired in the stretch. WHAT A JOY raced inside and had no response when roused. ANAMERICANBID raced between rivals and tired. CALL THE LARK was bumped at the start, raced four wide, tired and was eased in the stretch.
