SCOOTER RAT sprinted clear, raced uncontested on the lead and drew away under steady urging. BROCK N ROLL was well back after being bumped at the start, rallied along the rail leaving the turn and finished well inside. CARTER'S STORE pressed the winner along the rail and held for a share. PUREGOODNISS steadied in traffic on the far turn, raced between horses for a half and finished evenly. ODESSA'S HOPE stalked three wide into upper stretch and tired. JAYSTONE was unhurried after being bumped at the start, steadied in traffic on the far turn then faded. RIZTY ALY was never a factor. PASS THE NOTE trailed for most of the trip and angled out in midstretch. SMARTY KARAKORUM raced wide throughout and gave way in upper stretch.
