Footnotes

HAVE YOU EVER sprinted clear on the rail, shook loose in midstretch and drew away under mild left hand urging. GREAT EMPEROR was reserved for a half, split horses leaving the turn and closed steadily to edge MONTECORE for the place. MONTECORE prompted the pace outside the winner into upper stretch, but was no match for that one while being caught late for the place. JESS NOT JESSE chased three wide for a half and lacked a strong closing bid. BUDDY'S SONG never reached contention. GRIDIRON raced well back, advanced four wide on the turn and lacked a late response. RAMBLINGAMBLINMAN checked after being pinched at the start, saved ground to the turn and lack a further response.
