GAME TOKEN loosely stalked the early pacesetter near the three path, under a firm hold, during the opening half, advanced when ready, departing the backstretch, was asked for run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, struck the front, leading a tightly-bunched quartet into the stretch, edged to a more comfortable advantage during the ensuing furlong then held sway, driving. IDOL IMAGE brushed with GIMMEANOTHERWINK soon after the start, while racing over a slick, snow-covered strip, soon after the start, went on to bump lightly with the same opponent early on the first turn, holding ground in an attempt to avoid being floated outward during the run around that bend, sat perched four wide during most of the way down the backstretch and around the far turn, was called upon turning for home, failed to cut into the top one's lead and had to settle for being second best. GIMMEANOTHERWINK exchanged a couple of light bumps with the runner during the opening stages of the races, was kept in hand, unhurried towards the back of the pack, swung wide into the stretch and displayed a mild kick en route for the show. MARSCAPONI under a firm hold tracking the front runners from the rail, tried to grab the advantage cutting the corner into the stretch, but wasn't up to the task. THE PLOT THICKENS cut the pace towards the two path, came under assault approaching the quarter pole and readily succumbed. NEXT DAY took the inside route and was always outrun.
