Footnotes

ELECTRIC GOLD patiently tracked the front runners while taking the inside found, availed of an opportunity to ease off the rail coming to the three-eighths pole, moved up, issuing a challenge for the lead at the quarter pole, forged to the front during the run through the furlong grounds, then held sway, under a drive to the end. LADY DURLYN unhurried for nearly three-quarters, swung four wide into the lane and closed in gradually down the entire length of the stretch to grab the place. KITTYLICIOUS outrun for the initial six furlongs, commenced to rally from the five path at the head of the stretch and came home well belatedly for the show. BWANA BABE three wide most of the way around each bend, launched a bid leaving the three-eighths pole, gained a narrow edge leading the field into the lane, readily succumbed when the top one drew alongside in upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. MALIBU LEGACY strung out four wide around the opening bend, was a forward factor while well off the inside for three-quarters before backing off. PROUD ZOE showed the way from the inside, came under intense pressure from a pair of rivals approaching the five-sixteenths pole and gave way.
