POPPA'S PICK away well joined THE ZIPSTER on the front end, sparred with that opponent, began to edge away past the three-eighths pole, was let out a notch and extended the margin, drew off to a commanding margin under a hard drive from upper stretch until the sixteenth pole, before completing the race geared down. DRINK WITH PRIDE chased from off the inside and rallied well enough to get up for the place. LEAP DAY saved ground throughout. THE ZIPSTER got off alertly, had the winner drew alongside soon afterwards as a duel commenced, went on nearly even terms with that one until just past the three-eighths pole, fell back at that point and steadily tired. ZONE BREAKER urged cutting the corner, flattened out. SUMFUN was no factor. OCALA ROCKET angled out gradually from the quarter pole, made it into four path by the three-sixteenths pole, had no stretch offering to render. WADI SUKI was never in contention. SEWAN INDIAN well placed three wide off the ongoing duel, tired after entering the stretch, bled and was vanned off.
