Footnotes

SKITCHING broke well and grabbed a forward position, cut the pace from the inside, under the watchful eyes of three others down the backstretch and around the bend, turned for home with the second place finisher latched directly to the outside and got called upon, turned back AFTERNOON TREAT's challenge during the run through the furlong grounds, then drew clear from there, driving. AFTERNOON TREAT departed the backstretch from the four path, was the widest of three opponents applying pressure on the top one for most of the opening half, ranged up late on the turn to challenge in earnest, couldn't sustain the bid and had to settle for being second best. JAX MAXX broke slowly, was outrun for nearly a half, picked up interest coming to the quarter pole, was fanned five wide into upper stretch, to be the widest of all, and rallied down the middle of the track to get up for show honors. CAUSE I CAN quickly tucked along the inside, rode the rail before slipping outward past the five-sixteenths pole, got out finished. MR. HADIF took the inside route, was coaxed along on the turn to keep pace, cut the corner into the lane under a drive and tired. SAM HILLIC placed four wide at the top of the lane for the stretch drive, had no response. LINEAR MOTION disputed the pace between rivals for a good portion of the opening half before backing away. NEVERSAYWHEN gave chase three wide, at times from between opponents, and tired. BEAU DE BEAUPRE raced along the outside, was put to a

prolonged drive, folded. MANHATTAN BREEZE was grabbed hold after breaking a couple of steps, soon settled along the rail and saved ground to no avail thereafter.
