### Footnotes

ALPHA bobbed at the break, recovered and took up a forward position, stalked the pacesetter while racing three wide around each turn, crept up towards the leader coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was the widest of the three front runners spinning into the lane, poked a head in front at the furlong marker, then edged away from that station, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. STEPHANOATSEE bumped lightly with SPEIGHTSCITY as the pair made their way to the opening bend, sat reserved near the two path down the backstretch and for the initial portion of the run around the bend, was set down by the five-sixteenths pole, altered course to the outside in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, came home willingly once straightened away to grab the place. IL VILLANO away in good order, quickly established control, cut the pace, from the rail and rating kindly, came under heavy pressure from the two closest pursuers nearing the quarter pole and was let out in response, offered some resistance before surrendering the front in midstretch, weakened thereafter. HOW DO I WIN patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside for the opening three-quarters, was asked for a response and issued a challenge in earnest from between rivals late on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and backed away. SPEIGHTSCITY was bumped by an errant SHKSPEARE SHALIYAH at the start, became rank while brushing with another just before reaching the first turn, was pulled off that opponent and placed in the three path, continued from out there and folded. WHISTLEBLOWER took the inside route, was under a drive by the half mile pole, faded. SHKSPEARE SHALIYAH broke inward, was grabbed hold and taken off the nearest foe but not before making contact, saved ground until the quarter pole and was outrun.
