CAT SWEEP established command soon after the start, tucking along the rail in plenty of time for the run around the opening bend, set the pace, towards the inside, unchallenged and under a firm grip, began to edge away, departing the backstretch, still having been unasked for speed, was put to hand encouragement from the three-sixteenths pole to the sixteenth pole, before being more confidently handled, with the outcome no longer seeming to be in doubt. STORM 'N INDIAN off alertly, fought against the bit, being eased back early, conceding the front to the top one, took up position from the outside, stalking that rival, under a good hold, was put to strong encouragement at the three-eighths pole when the pacesetter began to draw off, then cut into the winner's margin late after that one was successfully geared down. ACADIAN BLUES underwent a three wide journey, was put to a prolonged drive, but proved no match for the top twosome. PERFECT VELOCITY bobbled after the break, was unhurried during the initial half, then improved belatedly, while never posing a threat at any time. AHGOGO along the inside soon after the start, altered course quickly to two path upon reaching the first turn, sat within range from there for three-quarters and tired. ASSURED VICTORY taken in hand, in reaction to AHGOGO's change of course coming to the seven-eighths pole, continued off the inside before settling on the rail midway down backstretch, saved ground thereafter and gave way.
