MARLINS ROSE worked out a tuck midway on the opening bend after being much wider departing the homestretch, contently tracked the front runners taking the inside route, from a distance, was let out a notch coming to the five-sixteenths pole, got put to much stronger handling entering the stretch, altered course in upper stretch to be placed to the outside of the threesome just up ahead, got straightened away and made steady progress towards them, got to the finish line in the last jump to prevail. GOING GOING GONE patiently stalked the pacesetter while racing three wide around each bend, moved up to increase the pressure heading for the quarter pole and got called upon, stayed latched on to STOCK FUND's hind quarters during the run through the furlong grounds, narrowed in thereafter, had the eventual winner arrive at the scene in the late stages and was denied the decision. STOCK FUND set the splits while being rated along the rail, continued to sail along on the same scenario for just over three-quarters, felt some pressure from the nearest pursuer for the initial time past the five-sixteenths pole and was soon set down, lost little if any of her advantage making her way to midstretch, dug in with determination leaving the furlong grounds, yet still had the margin dwindle down steadily, had to settle for show honors for all the effort after coming out on the short end of the win photo. WHO'S ZAT GIRL rated prompting the pacesetter to the quarter pole, tired. EUROKAY BY ME was steadied at the start and failed to menace. WILD KIMMIE broke behind the field after lunging at the break and was outrun thereafter. ZIPPY KITTY three wide on the first turn, folded. RUM TILL I DIE off the inside, was no factor. INSTANT FLASH faded off a ground-saving journey.
