### Footnotes

CAIXA ELETRONICA broke inward slightly, was pulled off the nearest opponent but not before brushing with that rival, left the backstretch four wide and was in that path for most of the run around the bend, got called upon turning for home, rolled by the front runners to poke a head in front at the eighth pole, then kicked clear, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. REGAL REVENGE took the inside route, launched a quick rail bid coming to the quarter pole, grabbed the lead between calls, had it snatched away by the eventual winner, but held on willingly to garner the place. J J'S LUCKY TRAIN was hand urged from the starting gate to secure the front, left the backstretch from just off the inside but soon drifted into the two path, got overtaken by the second place finisher's quick burst of speed heading into the stretch, remained well clear of the others for show honors. FRAZIL bumped lightly with the top one at the break, raced three wide on the turn and tired. RAVALO out hustled leaving the gate, continued from off the rail, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
