SUMMER SHARE steadied along the inside while lacking room at the five-eighths pole, saved ground while gaining at the quarter pole, steadied and angled three wide leaving the furlong marker and closed late to win going away. TRISTE DOBLE Q steadied slightly on the first turn, forced the pace in the two path, made a move to challenge in midstretch and outfinished GOODBYEANDGOODLUCK for the place. GOODBYEANDGOODLUCK set the pace along the rail into deep stretch and yielded late. TITLETOWN TIGER was under a firm hold in traffic on the first turn, raced between horses, steadied midway on the turn, angled three wide entering the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. SANCTUM showed early speed along the inside, raced up close for six furlongs, waited along the rail for room on the turn and weakened. ASK OMMADON checked after breaking slowly, trailed to the turn, followed the winner in upper stretch and lacked a late bid. EMPIRE EXPRESS raced four wide throughout, lodged a brief move outside on the turn and flattened out. STAY ALITTLE WHILE split horses on the backstretch then gave way on the turn.
