REIN KING broke outward, interfering with the nearest two rivals, was taken hold of and put back on a truer course in short order, set the pace slightly off the inside, with the rider applying rating tactics, responded positively when released from the firm hold, heading for the stretch and held sway. WON GREAT CLASSIC tracked the pacesetter within striking distance during the initial half, was put to a hard drive from the quarter pole, drew abreast of the leader from the inside, with enough room to spare for his challenge, appeared unable or unwilling to go by, had the rider alter course outward approaching the furlong ground, took another run at the top one but made up only a minimal amount of real estate. THUNDEROUS MOOD accompanied the pacesetter from the outside for a half and weakened steadily in the final furlong. PAX kept within range during opening half, had no rally. D'ARGENTO settled along the inside before reaching the half mile pole, rode the rail, angled sharply three wide approaching the quarter pole, but lacked the necessary stretch response. EX PAT veered out at the start, responding to inside pressure coming from REIN KING, raced well off the inside thereafter and tired. FORTY PRAYERS bothered at the start, saved ground throughout and was outrun.
