HEAD HEART HOOF out broke the field to grab the advantage, entered the turn being pursued by the runner up and was put to some hand urging, arrived at the midway point and got asked for yet more, went on to cut the corner under a drive, held ROYAL CURRIER at bay, kept busy to the end. ROYAL CURRIER chased the winner from the outside, was in the furlong grounds before being put to encouragement, proved no match. SATURDAY'S CHARM broke outward, leaning upon BE BULLISH and carrying that foe away from the inside for a few strides, raced towards the inside in pursuit of the front runners, got angled to be outside them turning for home and got outfinished. BE BULLISH got pushed outward a bit by SATURDAY'S CHARM leaving the starting gate, failed to get motivated when put to some hand urging soon afterwards, was in the two path for the run around the bend but closer to the rail for the stretch run, trailed.
