AWAKE AT T WIRE contently stalked FOLK SINGER from off the inside during the opening stages, advanced in unison with the runner up towards that opponent nearing the end of the backstretch, disputed the pace as the widest during the run around the far turn, had the inner member of the fight begin to back away midway through the furlong grounds, put away HOPPY DO after dueling with that foe for about another sixteenth and kicked clear. HOPPY DO briefly placed towards the inside, was primarily two wide until the quarter pole, contested the pace from between rivals on the second bend, had the battle spill over into the stretch and was called upon, fell back for good shortly after departing the eighth pole, continued onward in a willing manner to secure second against a weak and tiring pair. MATT AND JESSE saved ground for nearly six furlongs, got fanned into the five path during the initial portion of the stretch run, lacked the needed response. FOLK SINGER bobbled after the start, but went on to establish control quickly nevertheless, cut the first two splits facing only mild resistance, was allowed to drift outward proceeding down the backstretch, but was back towards the inside by the half mile pole, engaged in a tussle with another pair parked to the outside, was the first of the three combatants to have its pilot commit to a drive, this occurring a furlong down the road, yielded but stayed in contention until nearing the furlong marker before faltering.
