Footnotes

THE VIN MAN steadied at the start, checked in traffic on the far turn, circled five wide into the stretch and finished strongly to get up in the final strides. HOLLY TIME set the pace on the rail into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. GOLDEN MAN raced between horses early, advanced four wide on the turn and finished willingly to gain a share. MR. MESO pressed the pace between horses into midstretch and weakened. LIGHTS OF BROADWAY raced up close along the rail for five furlongs and tired. DR SILVER PACKET steadied along the inside midway on the turn and failed to threaten thereafter. KINGSGATE BAY (IRE) steadied at the start and never reached contention. INTIYACO (ARG) stalked four wide and faded leaving the turn. EXCEL raced evenly between horses. EXPLOSIVE COUNT angled in early, rallied inside on the turn and flattened out. SPEEDBALL HOWIE lodged a steady five wide move to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. TRANQUILO ducked out at the start, was never close thereafter and bled.
