Footnotes

THE TRUTH AND K G lunged inward at the start and made slight contact with IRON DALE AL, took up position as the closest pursuer soon afterwards, departed the backstretch three wide, moved when ready halfway around the turn, latched on and overhauled TWEET ME, gently asked for some run for about a sixteenth commencing from the five-sixteenths pole, drew out to a commanding margin from upper to midstretch, pilot atop with the lightest of hand movement, and remained well ahead, winning with something left. MR. LIT came four wide into the stretch and finished to be well clear of the others for the place. TWEET ME out broke the competition by a clear margin, settled momentarily down the rail but drifted into the two path before reaching the end of the backstretch, showed the way, pulling noticeably on the left side of the bit in reaction to the snug hold being applied by the rider on that side, got confronted by the winner late on the turn, had no answer and yielded readily before arriving at the quarter pole, then backed away. MAYBERRY MADNESS rode the rail, angled out three wide from the five-sixteenths pole, appeared to weakening when coming up to another's heels in upper stretch. IRON DALE AL brushed at the start, was never in contention.
