Footnotes

READTHEPROSPECTUS kept within range of the leader while taking the inside route, was released from a firm hold by the rider prior to angling outward for the start of the stretch drive, made up ground during the ensuing furlong, but much more in the next sixteenth, drew alongside the runner up with about a sixteenth remaining, took over for good seventy yards later and edged away, crossing the wire under hand encouragement. READTHEBYLINE quickly took control, cut the pace, being rated along the inside, got set down entering the stretch, had the eventual winner cut significantly into the advantage leaving the eighth pole, held on well before surrendering the lead past the sixteenth pole. BIGGER IS BETTOR was grabbed hold after taking an awkward initial step, raced from off the inside, got placed into the three path midway on the far turn, went wider still, until in the five path and under solid encouragement turning for home, made no headway on the front runners. PARACHUTE CONEY prompted the pacesetter from the outside, attempting to crank up the pressure as the field was completing six furlongs, wasn't up to the task at the hand, tired steadily after reaching the furlong grounds. THUNDER CHIEF faltered off a ground-saving journey. TAKE A WALK departed the backstretch three wide, fell back slightly during the later stages of the run around the far turn, was under strong handling swinging four wide into the stretch, tired.
