Footnotes

FORBIDDEN TALENT shied outward slightly, reacting to an incoming THREE CENTS, bumping lightly with CUCKOO HOUSE right afterwards, was hand urged to clear what was otherwise a tightly-bunched up group and grab command, got sent over towards the inside, showed the way from there, facing no resistance from the top of the bend to its end, got set down as the half was being completed and with a sizeable advantage and maintained it. THREE CENTS proceeded to move towards the outside as the field was sent on its way, causing the top one to tip outward as well and eventually into making contact with another, that being CUCKOO HOUSE, was tucked along the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, displayed an inclination of getting out, and actually did so, for much of the way around the bend, traded a series of bumps with CUCKOO HOUSE between the three-eighths pole and the five-sixteenths marker, needed to get checked hard to get her back on a truer course, had the pilot resume riding the mount and swung three wide entering the stretch, with the aforementioned rival, parked to her outside, following suit, came in sharply nearing the three-sixteenths pole, resulting in FRONT COVER DREAM getting steadied, continued onward to finish well clear of the others for the place. FRONT COVER DREAM was fighting on the bit tucking along the rail coming to the half mile pole, rode it for the next quarter, tipped outward for the commencement of the stretch run, steadied when impeded by the runner up a few strides past the three-sixteenths pole, bested the rest for the show. COOL IT placed four wide at the top of the lane, was outrun. CUCKOO HOUSE bumped with the winner very shortly after coming out of the starting gate, chased primarily from the two path on the turn, bumped several times with the second place finisher during the later stages of the run around the bend as that opponent was getting out, willingly or not followed the same rival by swinging three to four wide into the lane, gave way. An objection lodged by the rider of CUCKOO HOUSE against the rider of THREE CENTS alleging interference on the turn was not allowed.
