POP ROCKS showed good speed along the inside, split rivals nearing the stretch and dug in gamely along the inside in the drive. ALEX'S PAL was outrun early, raced wide and finished well outside. REASON TO HAIL raced with the pace from the outside and lacked a rally. VINEMEISTER contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. SHAKE SALT raced inside and tired. LETTHEFUNBEGIN contested the pace from the outside and tired.
