Footnotes

ALMIGHTY SILVER midpack early on while placed in the two path, came under hand urging just past the seven-sixteenths and advanced steadily on the front through the turn, loomed at the quarter pole now fully spirited up, took over in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths and edged clear being kept busy to the wire. GAMBLIN FEVER three wide most of the way, came under hustling nearing the quarter pole, rallied with good energy through the lane unable to close ground on the aforementioned rival while safely procuring the place. CALL THE BALL dueled inside for a half, slipped away near the seven-sixteenths to open up a clear lead, cut the corner into the stretch under urging, succumbed the front near the three-sixteenths, had no answer for the top two while able to stave off the remainder of the field for show honors. FRENCH TRANSITION raced four to five wide through the turn and swinging for home at the quarter pole, rallied mildly through the final furlong for the last major share. LEATHERHEAD saved ground throughout, came under a drive midway on the turn, ran on well until the final eighth, steadily weakened thereafter. DONTSTEALMYLAND chased three wide, was asked near the five-sixteenths for more, swung four wide at the quarter pole and lacked any late punch. POWER DREAMS rear early, rode the rail throughout, came under a ride midway on the turn and offered no response. FIRST GOLD dueled from the get go in the two path, came under a prolonged drive entering the far turn and folded. BERESFORD chased the pace while prominent three wide early on, began to back out near the five-sixteenths and was no longer persisted with by the rider, eased through the lane and was reported to have bled. COLJAK chased the pace early while three wide, lost action and was pulled up after a quarter and vanned off.
