Footnotes

INDY SCENT unhurried for nearly six furlongs, picked up the pace late on the far turn, was strongly handled angling four wide to the three-sixteenths pole, commenced to rally in earnest after completing the maneuver, wore down the front runners just past the sixteenth pole to take over, kicked away to a comfortable advantage soon afterwards and dug in well to hold on safely. PONI COLADA contently rode the rail under a good hold from the pilot, slipped off the inside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch and was asked for some run, was forced to steady off another's heels in midstretch, got going again and altered course to be the widest off all at the sixteenth pole, finished with good, but belatedly energy to procure the place. REGAL WARRIOR darted over to the rail soon after leaving the gate, saved ground for the initial stages, eased into the two path entering the backstretch, sat reserved making his way to the half mile pole, tipped outward one additional path for the run around the second bend, made up some ground on the front runners, spun into the lane and got called upon, finished willingly thereafter en route for the show. MAJESTIC HOPE raced along the outside, was set down from the five-sixteenths pole, made a good run to reach a prominent position with an eighth to go, but soon flattened out. EXPECTING CASH rated two wide

until the three-eighths pole, was let out a notch at that station, was put to much stronger encouragement soon afterwards, forged his way to a slim advantage by the furlong marker, but with a host of others in hot pursuit, remained in the thick of the fight for about another sixteenth, then weakened. BERNIE THE MAESTRO three wide around both turns, tired. HOCKLEY showed the way rated along the inside for the opening six furlongs, came under heavy pressure after entering the lane, offered good resistance before yielding just prior to the eighth pole. XODO along the inside, was put to a prolonged drive and tired. CREPE AU SUCRE got off slowly after swerving outward at the break, saved ground until the quarter pole and was outrun. MY ELUSIVE STAR three wide on the opening bend, had that path snatched away for the run around the subsequent one, was through after completing three-quarters.
