**Footnotes**

HACKLETON away well from the starting gate, worked his way past a well-retrained WILDHAASSEE to a clear advantage by the end of the homestretch, tucked along the inside, showed the way on a loosely-contested lead until the top of the far turn, felt some pressure leaving the half mile pole but shook it off before reaching the five-sixteenths pole, went on a little further then got called upon, lengthened away from upper to midstretch and remained well clear. WILDHAASSEE refused to rate kindly, fighting noticeably on the bit in opposition to the rating tactics being applied by the rider while making his way towards the first turn, showed signs of attempting to get out upon reaching that bend, and perhaps taking SUPERIORITY along for a short ride outward at that juncture, but was expertly kept along the inside route, continued to display eagerness after entering the backstretch, had that keenness result into being tightly pocketed leaving the half mile pole, forcing the rider to steady, lost some ground and momentum, got back going and more professionally, now under some hand encouragement, by the three-eighths pole, angled outward at the quarter pole, but could make no headway on the winner. ONEWILDRIVER saved ground, was under some encouragement spinning three wide into the stretch, came in slightly after being given some right handed stick work just SUPERIORITY was coming outward at the same time, resulting in solid contact between the two, mustered up a mild response to gain the show. DENDRITE off a couple of beats slowly, was unhurried from off the inside in the initial stages, unleashed an abbreviated challenge three wide upon departing the backstretch, got turned back and tired. PROMISED DESTINY was never involved. SUPERIORITY a forward factor along the outside for nearly three-quarters, was already backing away when bumping with ONEWILDRIVER in upper stretch, being co-responsible for the contact. KOMISAREK sent over to the rail soon after the start, was always outrun.
