EA assumed a forward position, patiently stalked the leader while sitting entrenched in the two path, moved up to initiate a duel shortly after entering the backstretch, raced heads apart with WAYWARD SAILOR, always the more confidently-handled of the two, put away the aforementioned rival midway around the third and final turn, lightly hand coaxed while doing so, had the rider shake the reins entering the stretch, then was given two left handed shots for good measure, completed the final furlong, handily. CHARLIE'S QUEST settled along the inside in the opening stages, was under some urging tracking the duel down the backstretch from afar, was put to stronger encouragement and got angled outward at the three-eighths pole, just as the loser of the pace fight was backing away, drifting out slightly down the lane while giving futile chase on the winner. WAYWARD SAILOR grabbed the lead after only going a few strides out of the starting gate, tucked along the inside, set the initial splits, well rated and with the eventual winner stalking just off his hind quarters, had that one latch on leaving the second turn, sparred on even terms for a bit more halfway down the backstretch, got shaken coming to the three-eighths pole, was set down attempting to come back, wasn't up to the task and faltered. GUYANA STAR DWEEJ off a beat slowly, raced along the outside, was through after going three-quarters. ROCKY WORLD faded off a ground-saving journey and got eased.
