Footnotes

ELNAAWI came in slightly at the start, initiating some contact with TELEGRAPH HILL, made a three wide on the first turn as the primary pursuer, vied for lead with REVOCATION with a path separating the pair for most of the way down the backstretch, grabbed the advantage and edged away coming to the half mile pole, then tucked along the rail shortly after departing that station, had the runner up flip flop into the two path in response to the maneuver, stayed under rating tactics, as did the second place finisher as the twosome made their way around the far turn, got set down turning for home, was kept to a drive and began to edge away during the final furlong. REVOCATION gained the early advantage, vied to maintain control while taking the inside route, lost the lead to the top one coming to the end of the backstretch, was switched over to be two wide after the top one got re-positioned along the rail near the top of the far turn, stayed within contention, was asked for a response spinning into the lane, kept up the pursuit in earnest until a little past the furlong marker, fell back steadily but held on well enough to preserve the place. INCOGNITO raced primarily from off the inside for the opening three-quarters, spending some time along the rail only during the early stages of the run around the far turn, had the pilot, attempt to get the mount more motivated, at times working with vigor while riding, turned for home two wide under strong hand urging, remained under strong handling all the way down the lane, found his best stride in midstretch, flashing good energy near the inside en route for the show, then galloped out noticeably well for about a furlong after crossing the finish line. BELLAMY BEACH raced along the outside, needed encouragement to keep pace with the rated pair up ahead on the far turn, tired. FREIGHT failed to menace. CHAMBERS BAY was always outrun. TELEGRAPH HILL bumped with the top one at the break, raced from off the inside, departed the backstretch under urging, folded.
