## Footnotes

RESERVED QUALITY made contact with the runner up as the field was sent off and running, picked up the interest during the later stages of the run around the bend while racing two to three wide, commenced the stretch four wide poised to strike, emerged from the furlong grounds in complete control, lengthened away the final eighth with the rider applying only gentle hand urging. TIGER WILLIE was bumped from between rivals at the start, was unhurried racing down the backstretch, picked up the pace upon reaching the turn, scurried into contention with a menacing run launched from the four path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home one path wider, maintained the momentum, arrived at the eighth pole with only the winner to catch, failed to do so and had to settle for being second best. FOGGY ROAD along the inside in the early stages, got angled into the five path during the opening portion of the stretch run, rallied for the show. LITTLE WYATT sat within range from just off the inside on the turn, was forced to remain on hold, stuck behind a multi-numbered wall turning for home, crawled along a narrow opening along the rail corridor, slipped by another coming to the eighth pole to gain sufficient racing room, came up empty. PLEASURE PRINCIPLE was put a hand drive leaving the starting gate to secure a prominent position, was between rivals vying for the lead on the turn, gave way after going a half. MR. STYLE departed the backstretch from the three path, contested the pace as the widest of a threesome to near the quarter pole then backed away. CACTUS CITY ROAD was sent over the rail, tugged noticeably on the left side of the bit proceeding down the backstretch, departed it and was forced to dispute the pace with another pair parked to the outside, kept it up to the quarter pole and faltered. BEAT OF THE DRUM was driven early to reach midpack, raced two wide on the turn and tired. TWEET ME broke outward, bumping with TIGER WILLIE, was two wide at the half mile pole, started to back away steadily
