FAIRY SNOW coaxed three to four wide just off the pace, ranged up to challenge nearing the quarter pole, swung four to five wide set down for the drive into upper stretch, edged away briefly to the eighth pole, dug in under threat through the final sixteenth and held on to prevail. ONE RED CAT three to four wide in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide for home, rallied willingly through the final eighth and missed on the wire. APEX saved ground towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch, angled out a path a furlong out around the weakening former leader, improved belatedly to garner the show while never threatening the top pair. ST. SINCERE vied three to four wide outside a trio early on, shifted to the three path as CORYBANT backed out three furlongs out, got set down nearing the quarter pole spinning three wide for home, kept on mildly to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. WOBURN just off the inside in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, offered no serious response while passing tired rivals in the stretch. MR RODRIGUEZ two to three wide towards the rear, got ridden along from the five-sixteenths, spun four wide for home, offered no rally while improving position by tired ones in deep stretch. M P RUCKUS vied from the two path between foes coaxed along with a trio early on, came under further encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home and faltered in

the drive. KELTIC FIGHTER saved ground towards the rear ridden along from three furlongs out and made no impact. CORYBANT vied with a trio from between foes briefly from the three path until the three-eighths pole, retreated through the latter portion of the turn and tired. TWO MORE JACS hustled from the start, vied inside a trio to the three-eighths, came under urging at the five-sixteenths under continued battling with a pair, got headed nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch and folded, then was not persevered with through the final eighth and was pulled up quickly after the wire.
