PENTATONIC was unhurried while outrun early, rallied wide on the second turn, finished determinedly from the outside and was clear in the final yards, driving. STROLLING BELLE was rated along early, advanced inside on the second turn, angled out in upper stretch and stayed on gamely to earn the place. POMPEII raced close up while in hand, rallied three wide on the second turn, drew clear in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. BACK IN SHAPE was outrun early, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and finished well outside. BIOGIO'S ROSE was rated along early, saved ground and stayed on well inside. DON'T PINCH ME was hustled outside, argued the pace and tired in the stretch. PERLINDA (ARG) showed speed along the inside, argued the pace and tired after three quarters. GOLD STREAMER chased outside and tired.
