SMOOTH JAZZ raced a bit greenly early on, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, drew clear when roused and was kept to a drive to the finish. RANDY'S BULLET hesitated at the start, came away slowly, was outrun while racing greenly early, settled along the inside nearing the stretch and finished full of run. PSYCHIC contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. SUM PUNCH contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. THOMPSON ST. chased the pace from the outside and tired after a half mile. COMPANY MAN dropped back early, raced inside and tired.
