DIAMOND DISTRICT contested the pace in the two path, took charge at the quarter pole and drew away under steady right hand urging. SMART ENUF was well placed in the two path to the turn and finished willingly to clearly best the others. NO HALO ON ME was under a firm hold, advanced four wide on the turn and lacked a strong late response. NEXT DAY saved ground to the turn and finished evenly. PRINCEOFFPROXIMITY raced between horses on the turn, checked in traffic at the quarter pole and tired. OF ALL TIMES set the pace inside the winner to the turn and gave way. ROBACHINO was never a factor. PATENT PENDING TOM trailed along the inside.
