OPUS A raced as a team with the runner up departing the starting gate, was taken hold and eased back into the role of stalker approaching the first turn, kept a watchful eye from the two path on the well-rated pacesetter until just past the half mile pole, was let out a just a notch and accelerated towards LOVELY LIL and drew abreast, raced heads apart for the remainder of the run around the far turn, appeared to take away the lead from the more energetically-handled second place finisher approaching the quarter pole, got called upon entering the lane, dueled on even terms for the initial portion of the stretch drive, shook free suddenly just prior to the eighth pole, then kicked away comfortably under good handling. LOVELY LIL showed the way from the inside with the rider applying a firm hold on the reins, had the winner draw directly alongside in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, needed to be asked for a response about a furlong down the road to keep pace, fell back a short distance from the furlong marker, but continued onward willingly to procure the place. LADY GRACENOTE angled three wide at the three-eighths pole, mustered up a mild stretch response en route for show honors. MINERALOGIST saved ground throughout, got roused from midpoint on the far turn, failed to reach a contending position. LYNDSSEA'S MISS EL broke outward, loosely stalked the front runners from off the inside, tired.
