FAST FLEET CAT broke near the back of the pack, was put to mild hand encouragement to secure a forward position, got taken hold of when briefly wedged between rivals soon after entering the turn, moved away from that pair and ranged up readily from the two path in the direction of the pacesetter, drew alongside and issued a challenge as the field headed into the stretch, drew away to emerge from the furlong grounds in possession of a comfortable advantage, remained well clear thereafter, crossing the finish line, hand urged. SUNNY DESERT broke outward, was grabbed hold and put back on course, angled towards the inside and made it to the rail in time for the run around the bend, began to pick up the pace from the five-sixteenths pole, vacated the inside in upper stretch, came home with good energy to garner place honors. BONATINI rode the rail in the early going, was angled outward and squeezed her way between opponents just past the five-sixteenths pole, rallied well down the lane to secure the show. RIVER'S END bumped lightly with BRINGHOMETHEGOLD at the start, settled along the outside near midpack, left the three-eighths pole from the three path, launched a mild stretch bid to

take the last major slice of the pot. SUAVE N SASSY three wide departing the backstretch, gave chase, flattened out during the last eighth. BRINGHOMETHEGOLD was steadied after being brushed at the start, went on to improve position during the stretch run. FIFTYFIVEFIFTYFIVE raced three wide on the turn, lugged inward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, impeding the progress of another pair. SPEEDING ON BY set the pace from the inside, came under pressure from the winner nearing the quarter pole, soon succumbed and gave way. MADAME PROSECUTOR was never in contention. LOST BADGE raced in midpack from off the inside, was forced to be steadied when bothered by another in upper stretch. I'M THE MIZZ forwardly placed from inside, backed away after completing half, then was forced to be steadied when bothered in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole.
