Footnotes

MY WAY OR DUBAIWAY forwardly placed on the pace just off the inside, widened away through the turn under light urging, spun three wide for home, got roused straightening away, went clear through the stretch kept busy to the end. PATRIOTIC DUTY three wide towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, swung four wide for home, offered up a mild kick to procure the place while no match for the winner. SLIMSHADY tracked the pace along the inside, got called upon at the five-sixteenths, made a mild bid to the furlong marker before weakening late on. POWER OF THE HEART chased the front three to four wide through the turn coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths and weakened. FISH HOOKS broke well to the front, settled in the one and one, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths and weakened. GRANTIGGAN saved ground towards the rear, was placed to encouragement at the three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the stretch and offered no kick. PATRIOT CLASS three wide in close pursuit initially, got ridden along from the three-eighths pole, retreated in the latter portion of the turn, cornered four wide in upper stretch and tired. MAC'S INK broke in at the start stumbling soon after and lost the rider. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start concerning MAC'S INK which resulted in no change prior to the race being declared official.
