Footnotes

NOTESFROMABROAD broke outward a couple of steps, bumping with MS.STARELLA as a result, went on to grab a narrow advantage, showed the way from a slight distance off the rail, with the rider keeping something in reserve all the while, got asked for a response commencing the stretch run two wide, held the advantage while keeping a straight course during the ensuing furlong, began to drift outward, forcing the runner up to do so likewise or risk the possibility of making solid contact, held on safely to preserve the decision. ROCK N COZY was put to a good hold by the rider after the start, was bumped by an errant TINA'S NOTE while between rivals near the nine-sixteenths pole, moved up eagerly after the incident, rider still atop with a firm grip on the reins, trying to take some of the edge off the mount's keenness, was forced to steady when caught in tight between rivals leaving the half mile pole, got going back in short order, bided time, still being rated, the rest of the way around the bend, entered the stretch then altered course and availed of a newly-created opening along the three path in upper stretch, reached the eighth pole as the main pursuer of the top one, gained ground readily despite being forced to imitate the drifting out antics of the winner in the late stages, missed. MS. STARELLA was grabbed hold and allowed to shy outward after making contact with the top one at the start, prompted that opponent from the outside for the opening half and tired. TINA'S NOTE away in good order, began to display an inclination to get out, had the rider apply on a strong hold on the left side as a counter measure, gave chase on the front runners three wide for most of the way on the turn, moved outward a bit more swinging into the stretch and tired. FERRITTO saved ground until upper stretch and faltered. LIL'BELLA was never in contention.
