SCHIVARELLI got bumped hard from both sides at the start, was slow to settle into stride, displaying greenness by appearing to climb during the initial stages, caught up with the pack, looking headstrong, and fighting with force against the snug rating hold being utilized by the pilot, was given some rein by having the rider switch over to some hand urging during the early stages of the run around the bend, settled down considerably, yet still reached out greenly, swung four wide into the stretch and got called upon for a response, gave it, making up good real estate during the initial portion of the stretch drive, continued onward, took off with strong burst of energy leaving the sixteenth pole, overpowering the runner up a few jumps prior to the wire to grab away the decision. FERLIN HUSKY was brushed shortly after the start, went on to assume command, was kept on hold showing the way towards the inside on what was a loosely-contested lead for much of the opening half, drifted into the two path in upper stretch, held his ground well from there to midstretch, proved hapless to match the winner's impressive late speed as that rival sailed by in the final stages and had to settle for the place. SMARTY BURNS chased three wide and got outfinished. KILLER CROSSOVER bumped soundly right after the start, tracked the front runners from the pocket, was asked for run after going halfway around the bend, vacated the rail turning for home, made no headway. SUBLIME saved ground for nearly a half, got taken four wide into the stretch, had no rally. HARD FAST CASH broke inward, bumping hard with the top one, chased the pacesetter from the two path on the turn, tipped outward a couple of more paths by upper stretch, tired.
