Footnotes

PETE'S FLEET sparred with MAYBRY'S CHALLENGE for command nearly from the get-go, had that rival drift into the three path coming to the end of the backstretch and thus wound up disputing the pace being four wide for a majority of the way around the bend, edged away from that one past the five-sixteenths pole, got set down for the drive home spinning into the lane, getting taken over closer to the rail as well, emerged from the furlong grounds in possession of his biggest advantage, held on well enough to safely to prevail. KICK'N BUTT was guided over to the rail at the half mile pole, rode it for the next quarter, was set down to a hard drive angling outward at the top of the lane, cut the winner's lead in half during the final furlong with a steady gain of ground. TACTICAL PAL was placed along the inside route and stayed put along it until approaching the quarter pole, fanned outward until about seven wide by the three-sixteenths pole, kicked into his best stride to arrive at the eighth pole having good momentum, maintained it to take the show award. LET'S DISCUSS gave chase from the two path, altered course on the second attempt by the rider in upper stretch, lacked a solid closing response. CHANNEL BOY saved ground on the turn, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths marker, tired. ESSENCE OF A HERO broke towards after spring forth from the gate, was pulled away in time from the nearest opponent before any significant contact was made between them, raced from off the inside, ducked in a couple of paths while being green in midstretch, recovered well enough to outfinish a pair of weak and tired ones afterwards. ASTRONOMO raced along the inside and faltered. MAYBRY'S CHALLENGE drifted into the three path coming to the end of the backstretch, vied for command from there with the eventual winner parked out one path wider, started to back away a short distance from the quarter pole.
