I'LL BUY was unhurried while racing outside under a firm hold, picked up the pace departing the backstretch, once asked for some run, spun three wide into stretch, full of speed and under rousing, gained readily on the leader, collared and sped past that one a few strides prior to leaving the furlong grounds and drew off under steady encouragement to the wire. BUDGET placed under a good hold leaving the starting gate, moved up willingly down the backstretch, sat perched just off the pacesetter's hind quarters to assure an honest pace, bided time for nearly seven furlongs, took off to issue a challenge for the lead coming to the five-sixteenths pole, struck the head of the stretch now holding command, came under pressure from the top one by upper stretch, succumbed, but was kept going well enough to secure the place. THE ROUNDHOUSE loped along taking the inside route until the quarter pole, angled outward for the stretch drive and rallied to finish a non-threatening third. BEDROCK BLUES rode the rail, was put to encouragement long before reaching the half mile pole, trying to keep pace, angled three wide into the stretch and got outkicked. FRENCH TRANSITION saved ground until the eighth pole to no avail. THREE IN THE BAG broke well and quickly established control, cut the pace from the inside, rated and being mildly pressed by the runner up, had no answer when one moved up to challenge in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths, steadily tired after being displaced on the front. COPPER CASCADE raced along the outside and folded after completing a mile.
